

Premium Steel Series Technology

1. Steel Panels Walls 42" Height ... 40" Finished Water Depth

The top, bottom and vertical flanges, as well as panel stiffeners (Z Braces) are secured using the togglelock fastening system. The result being a panel and maximum strength, minimal deflection, and a perfectly square structure each and every time.

2. A-Frame Brace

One of the several types "A" adjustable wall supports that assure a straight square structure with or without water.

3. Deck Brace

The use of deck braces permits concrete or other decking material to be installed immediately after the pool is installed, without waiting for the back fill to settle. The inverted "A" shape transfers the weight of the deck to the base of the wall using the outward pressure of the water to equalize the stress on the wall.

4. Skimmer Support

Designed to support the weight of the skimmer during and after backfilling, the skimmer support fits securely under the skimmer on the wall's bottom flange.

5. Copper Bearing Walls

Steel panels are constructed of *U.S. STEEL* 235 Copper Bearing Galvanized coating.





UNDERSTANDING LENGTH OF POOL DEEP END vs SHALLOW END




UNDERSTANDING DEPTH OF POOL...NON-DIVING POOL

OPTIONS OF BOTTOMS




WHAT DEPTH SHOULD I MAKE MY POOL?





Additional Cost Not Included In Price of Pool

Permits:

Can range from \$350 to \$2,800. This depends on the Township and if they require Certified Engineering Drawings. Doctor Feelgoode's coordinates and prepares the permit.

Electrical Requirements:

\$3,595.00 which includes a complete Electrical Control box with necessary Timers, GFI's and 110 Outlet. This price includes hook up to the customers Electrical Box within 75' from the filter pad.

Additional Electrical Charges

- Hook up is longer than 75'
- Electrical box does not have adequate breakers
- Customer purchase a Heat Pump \$975.00 Extra
- All Inspections are paid by customer

Water:

Water is necessary to "Set" the liner correctly. In most size pools (2) loads or 13,000 gallons are required. Large pools would require more. The average cost of (1) truck of water or 6,500 gallons is \$450.00. Pools with Special Liner Cover Steps may require an additional 3rd truck.

Dirt Removal:

Dirt removal can range from \$1000.00 to \$1,300.00 (trucking time). This cost depends on the distance to take the dirt to a disposal site, the number of trucks needed and if we have to **pay for public disposal site**. We always try to find a free disposal sites, however if one is not available, than it will be required the use of a public disposal site (**extra cost**).

Grading of Property:

We backfill your property as part of the contract. If you would like additional regarding after the completion of the cement decks around the pool, there will be an additional charge of \$600.00. We strongly suggest that the customer be home to approve the work completed on the initial Backfill.

Warranties:

All Warranties will be registered with the manufactures upon completion. This is something that we do to protect your investment. Extended Warranties beyond the Manufactures Warranties, can be purchased through Doctor Feelgoode's.

Inspections:

During construction Inspections will be called in my the installer. If there is a cost beyond that of the permit you will be billed. It is also the responsibility of the Home Owner to call in all **final inspection**. This is an obligation to insure that you receive the final Certificated of Completion.
